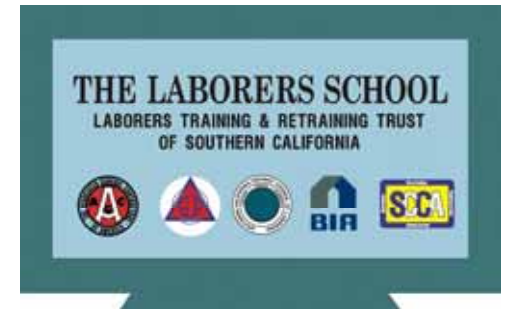

8. TILT-UP CONSTRUCTION (40 hours)
